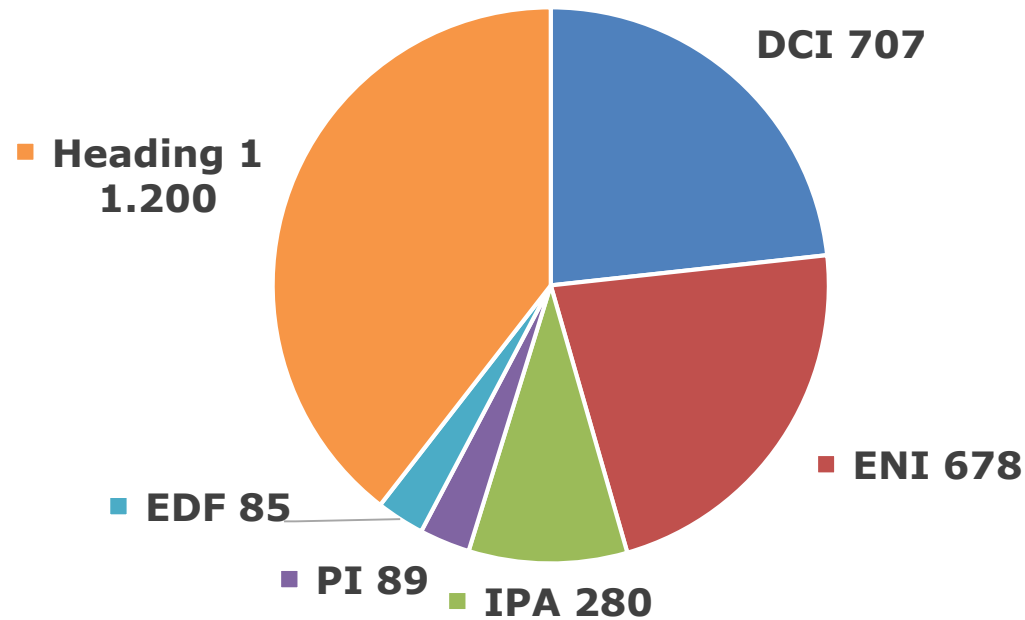

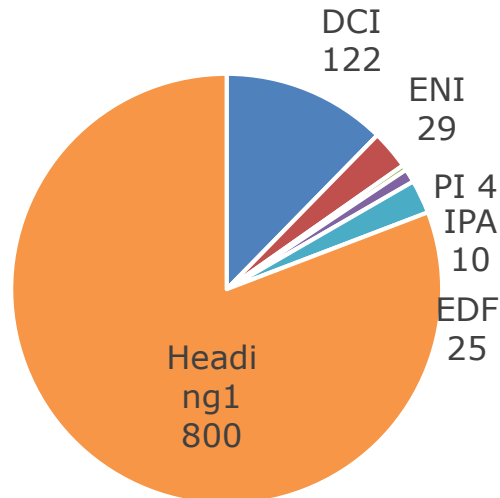

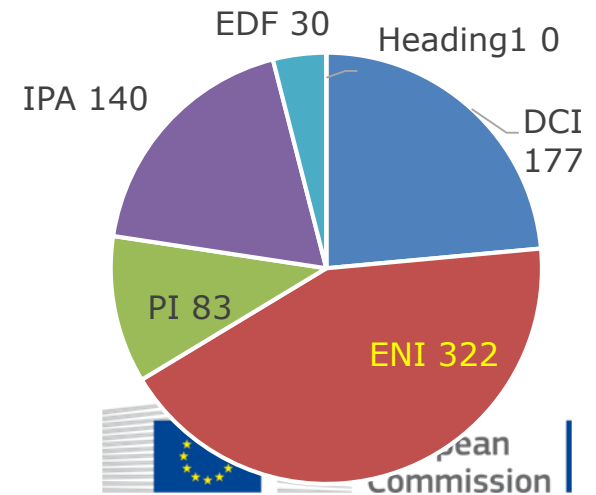
Capacity Building in HE mEUR

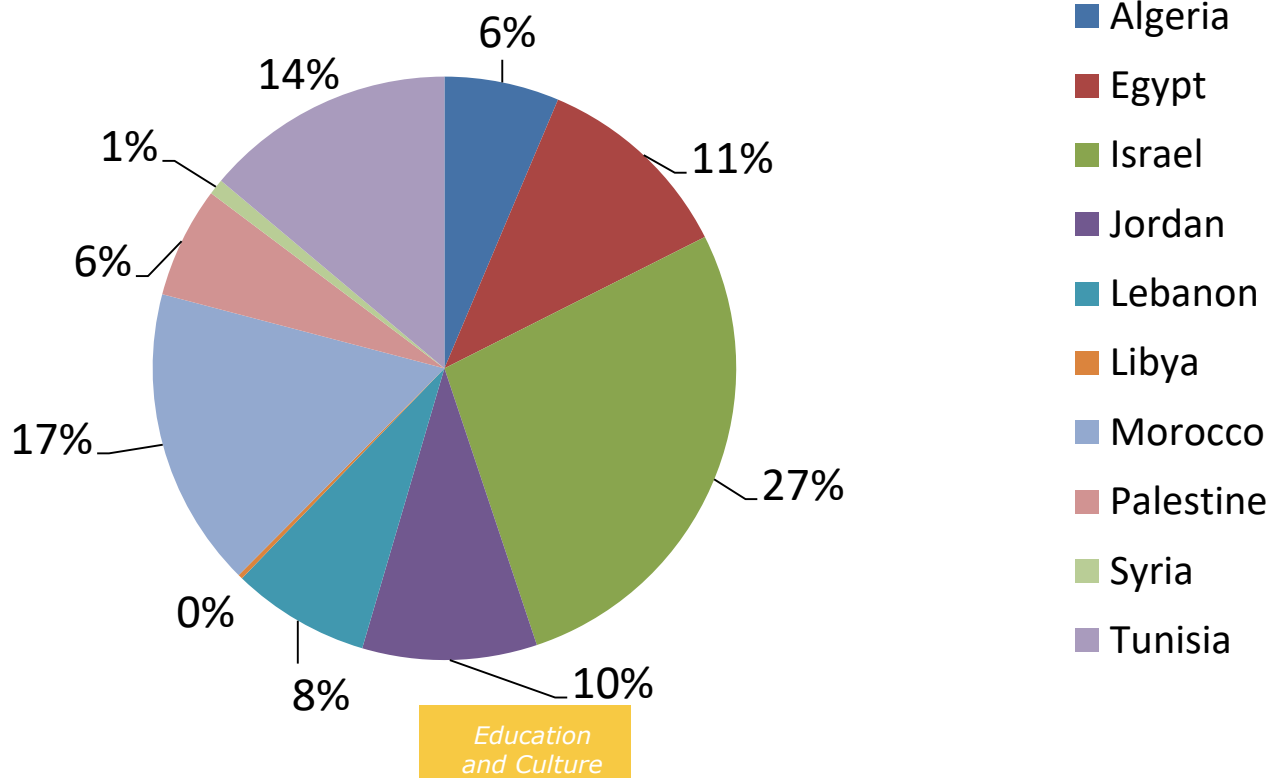

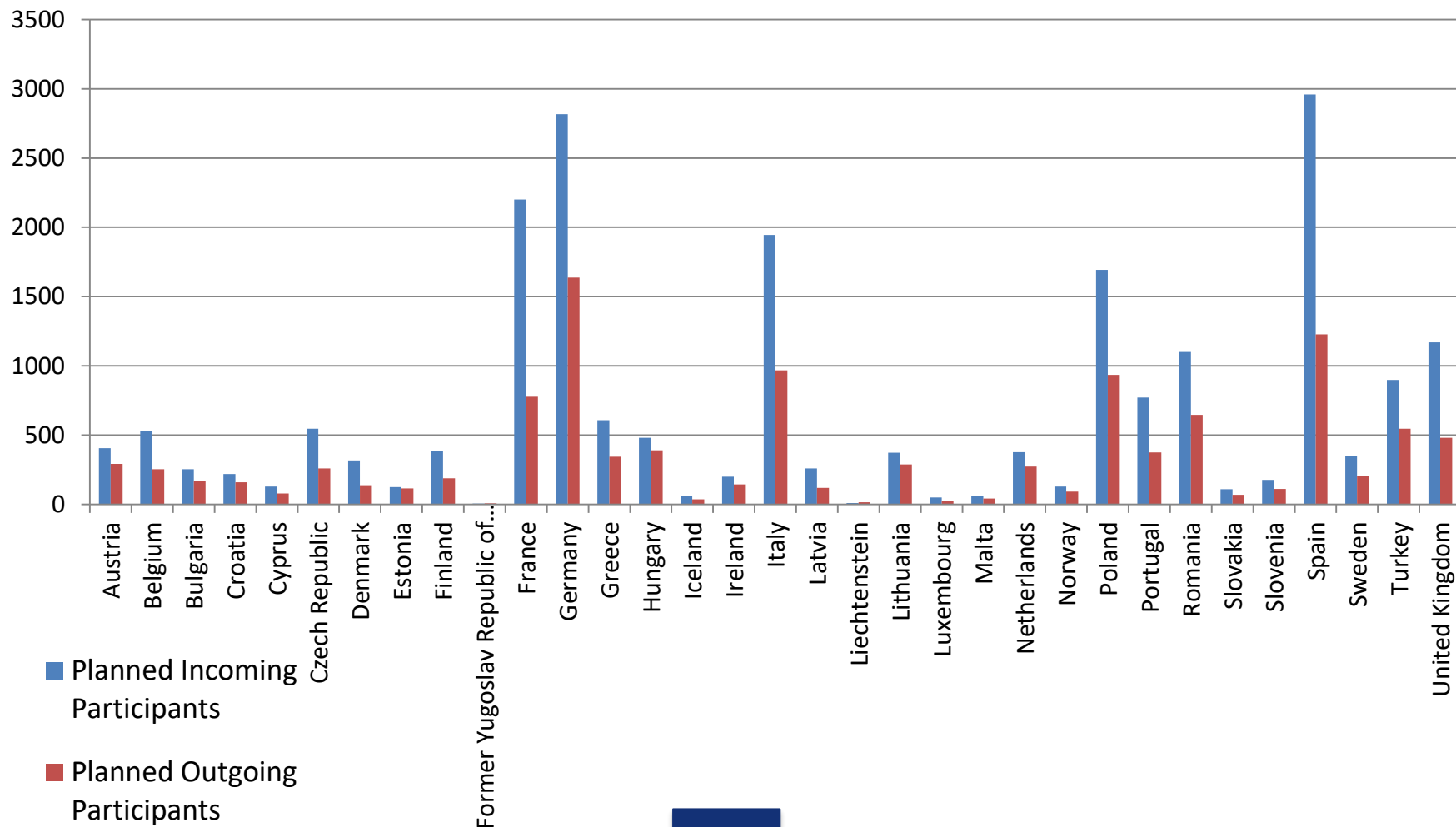
Share of planned mobility flows- 2015-2018

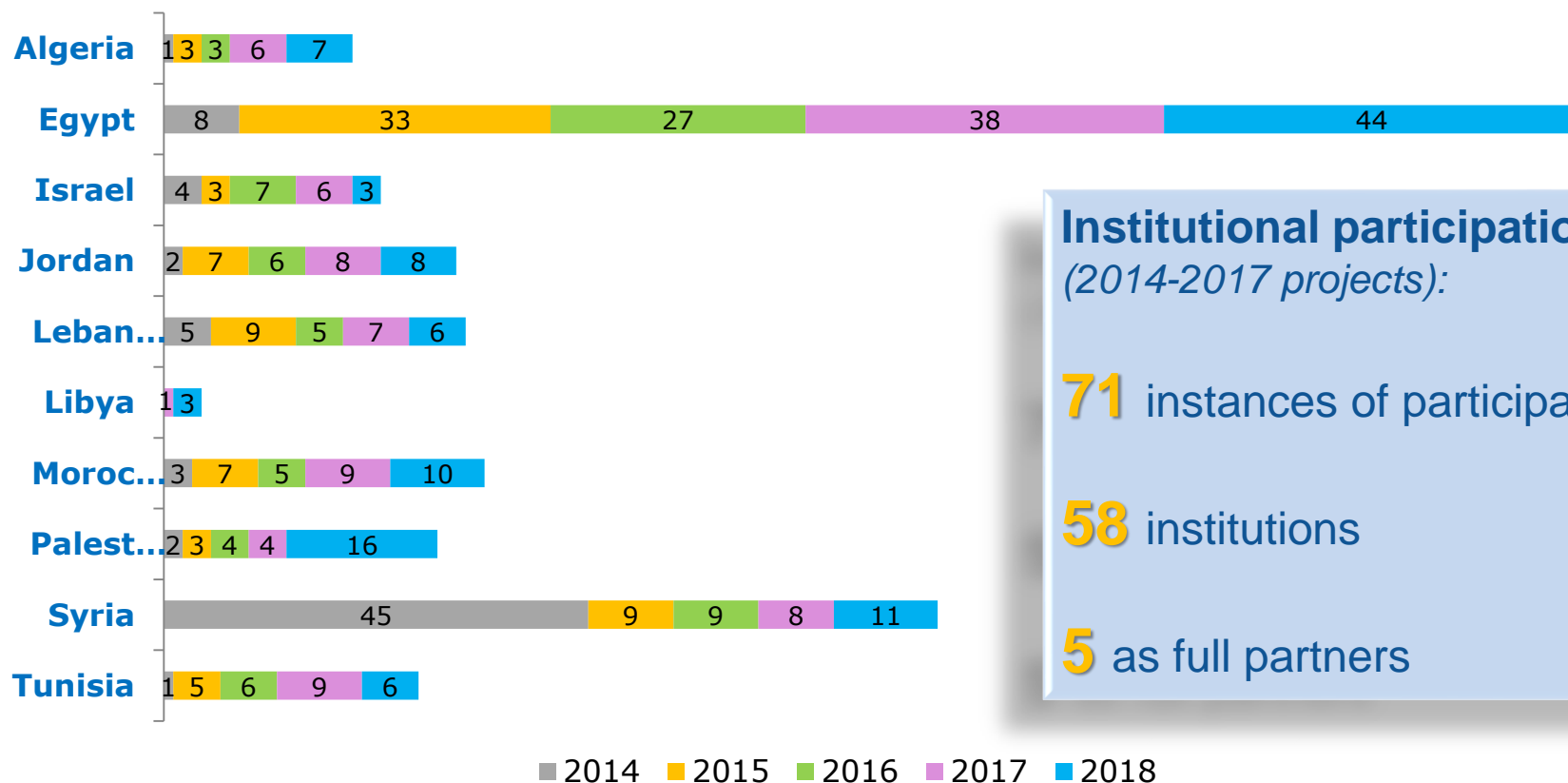

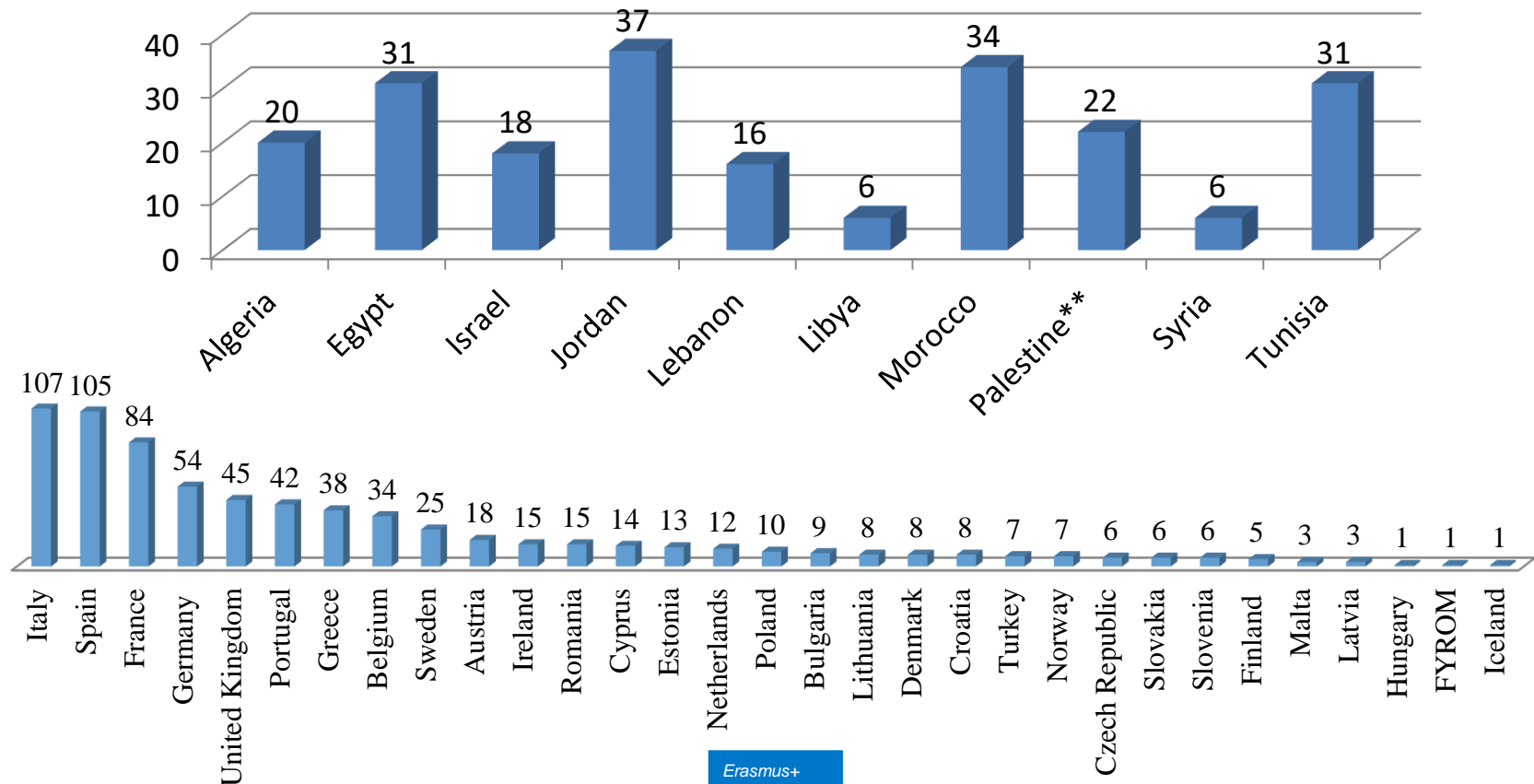

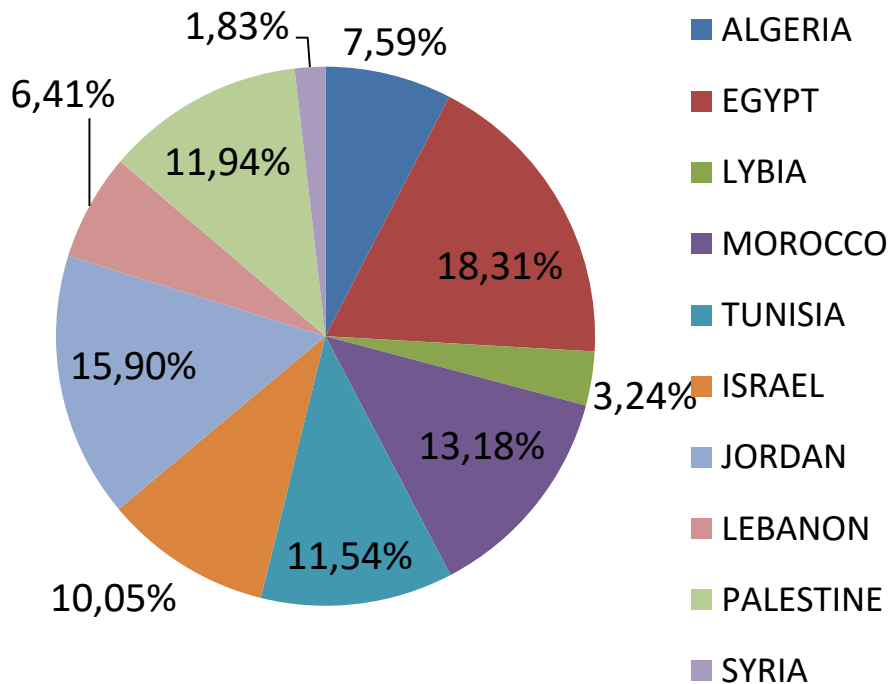

Budget: 118,3 M€ over 4 calls



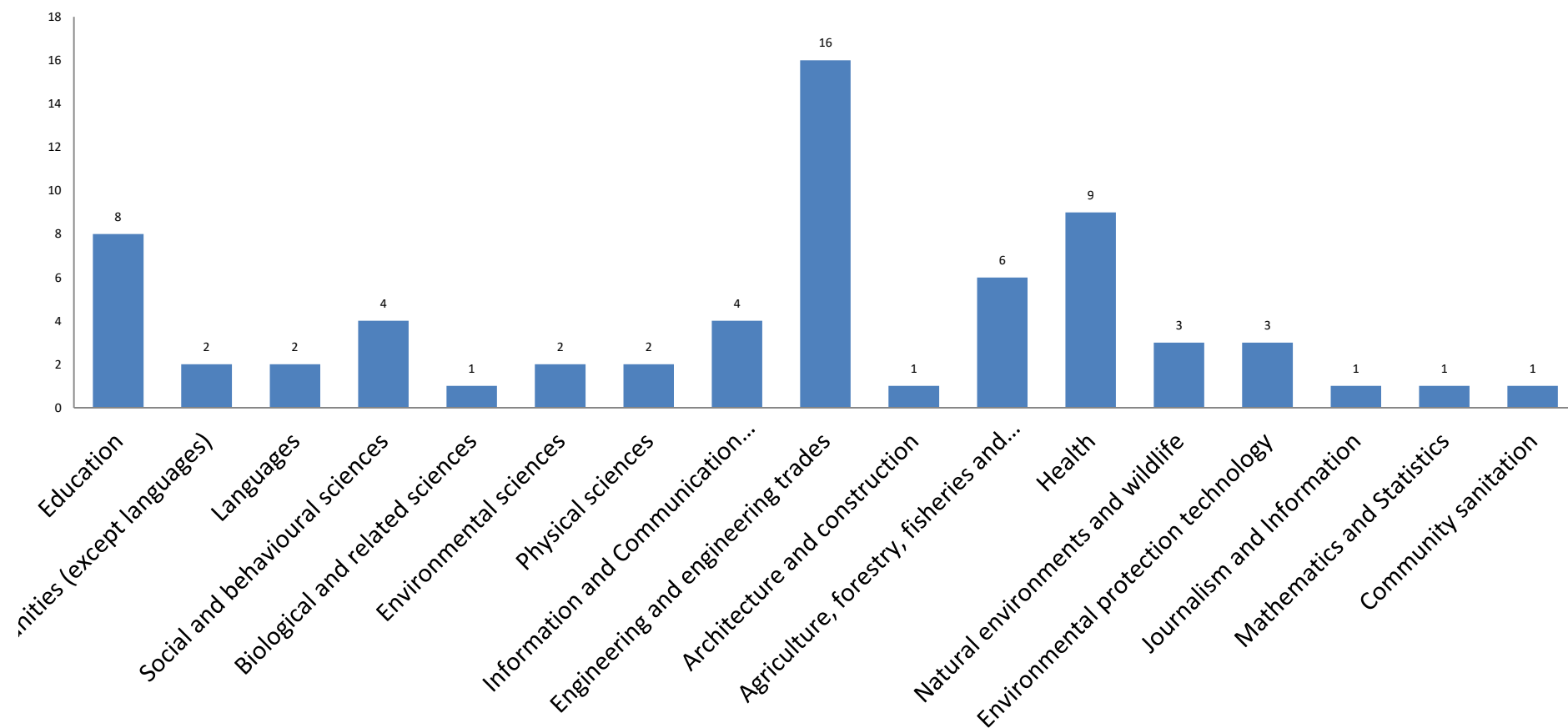
Types of the 142 projects:

mainly in Maghreb Countries

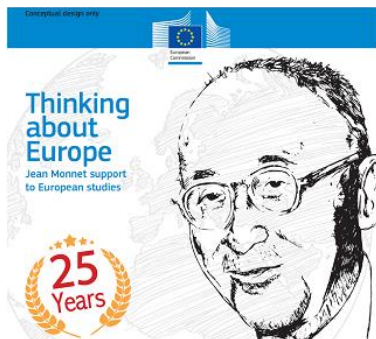
80 National projects

mainly in Middle East countries

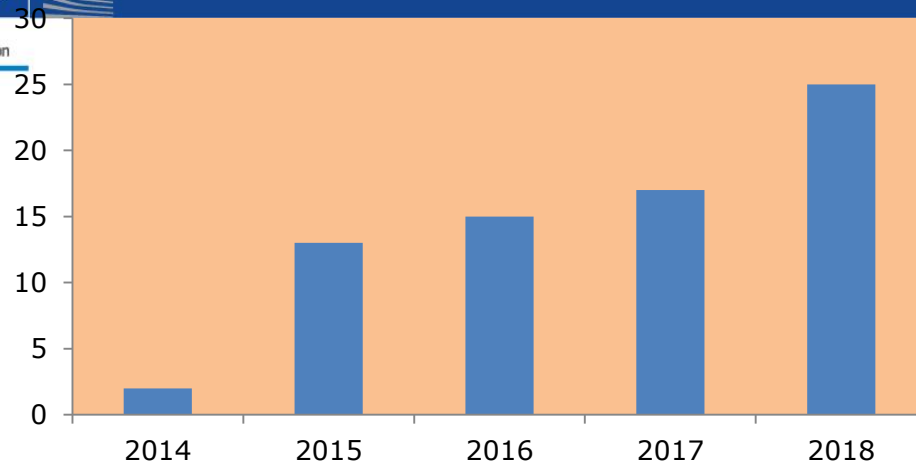
CBHE projects on Curriculum Development 2015-2018



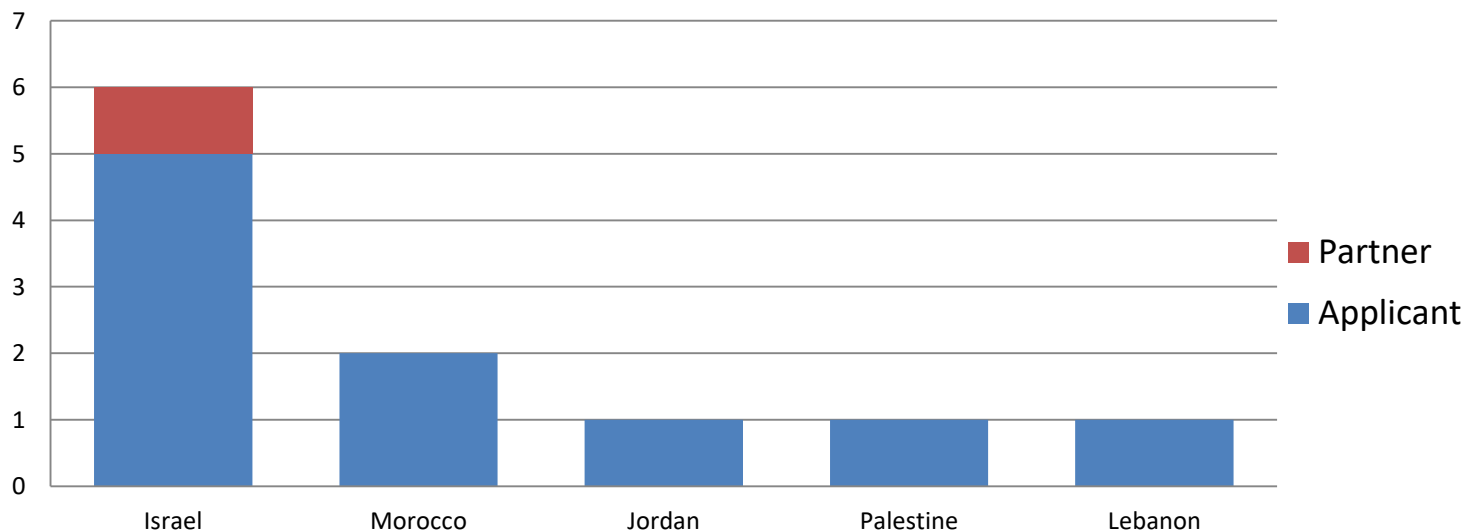

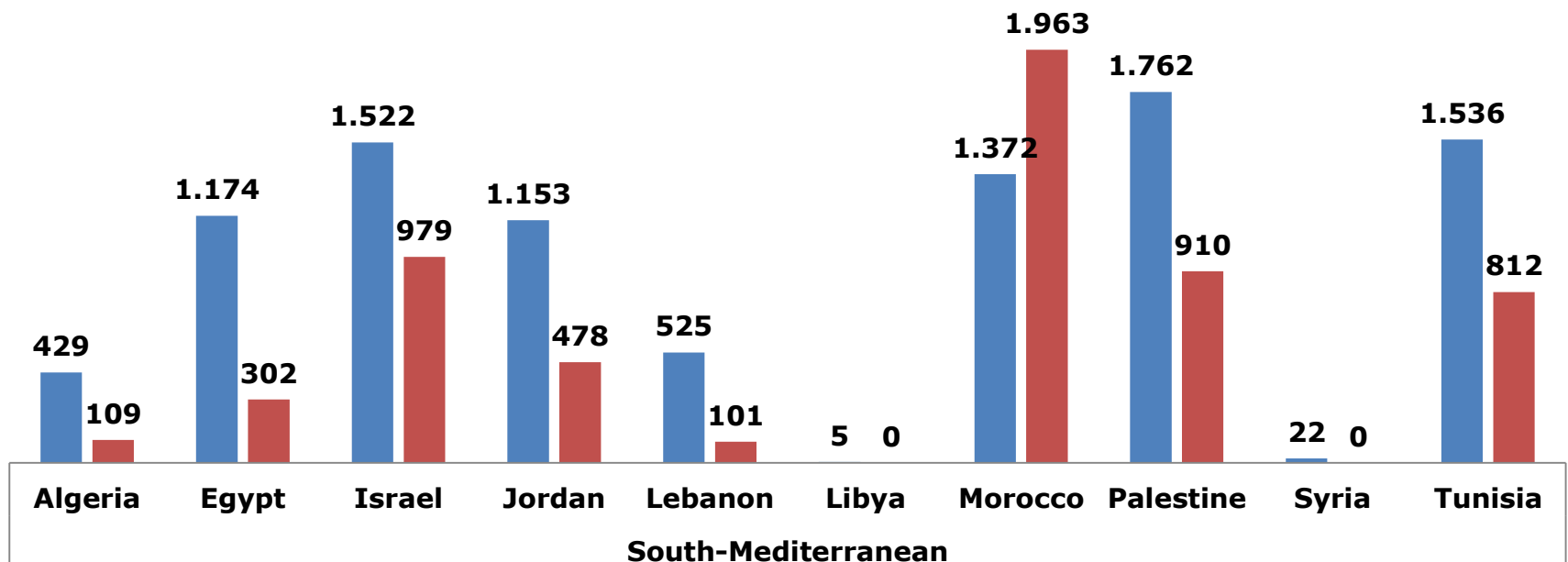

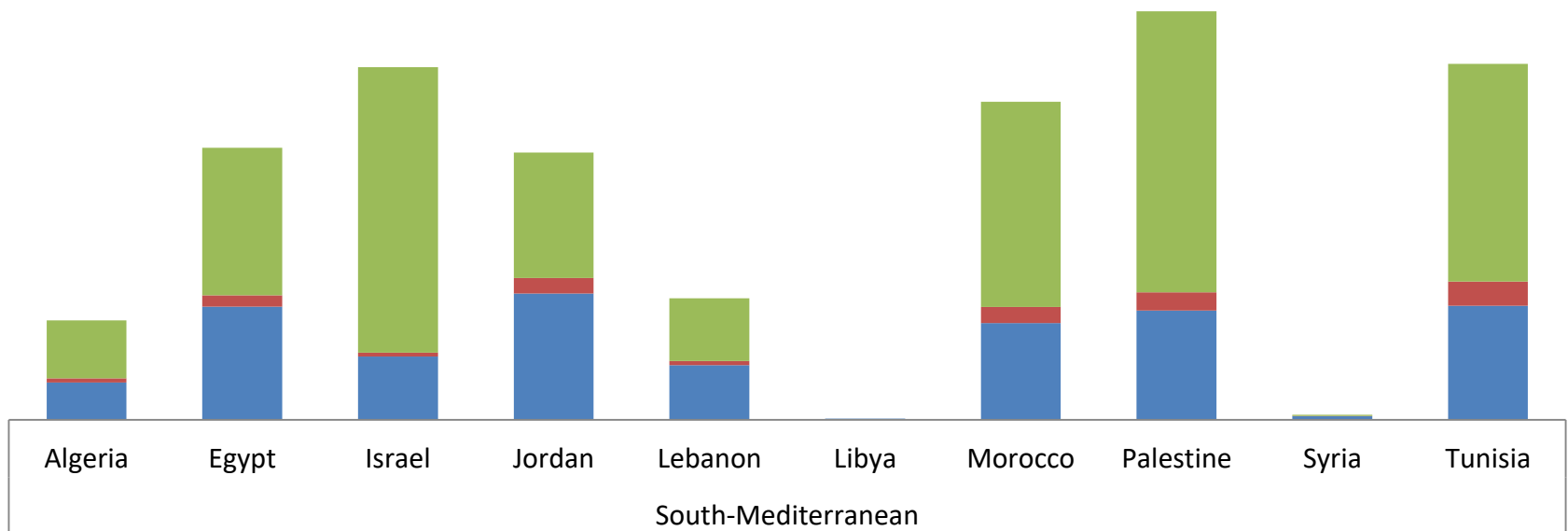

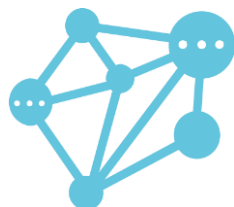
