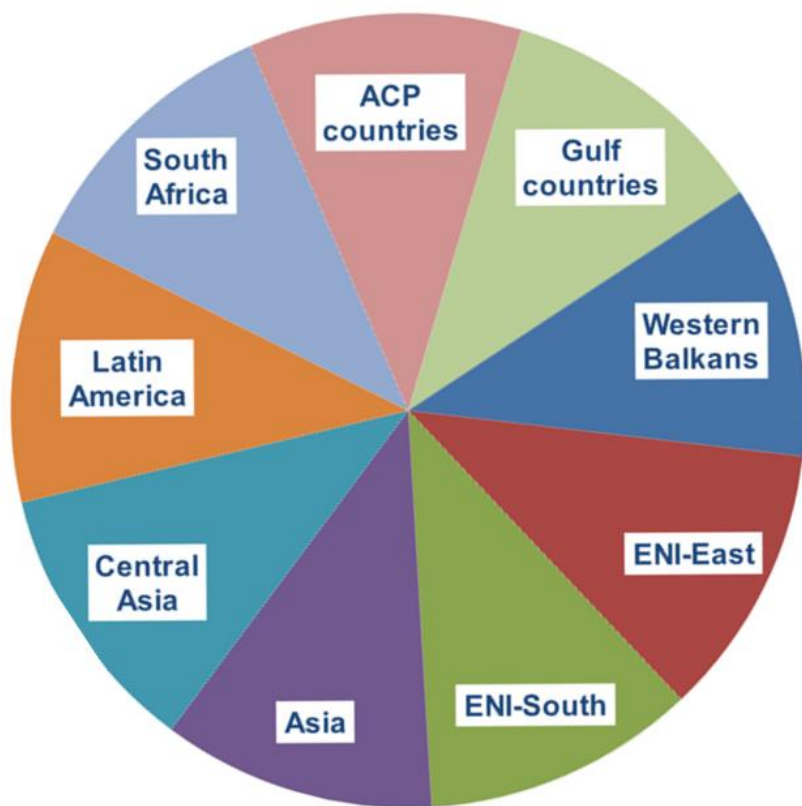
- 50.000 € per student intake (max 4)
 - 20.000 € for optional preparatory year
- = 220.000 € max.

Students



- 25.000 € max. per scholarship per academic year
- includes:*
- ✓ *participation costs*
 - ✓ *travel & installation costs*
 - ✓ *subsistence allowance*

Additional scholarships for 9 targeted regions



- ✓ Financed through EU external funding instruments
- ✓ Consortia may receive up to **28 additional scholarships**

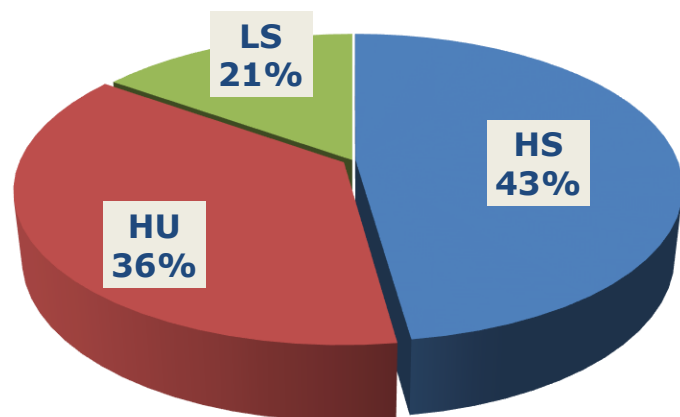
Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees

...in brief:

- Increased budget for the 7-years-period
 - around **1 billion €**
 - allowing to support **≈ 250 EMJMDs** and
 - **≈ 28.000 scholarship holders** - 75% for students from Partner Countries

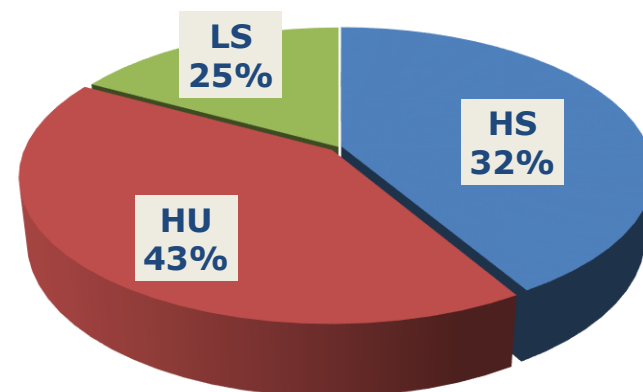

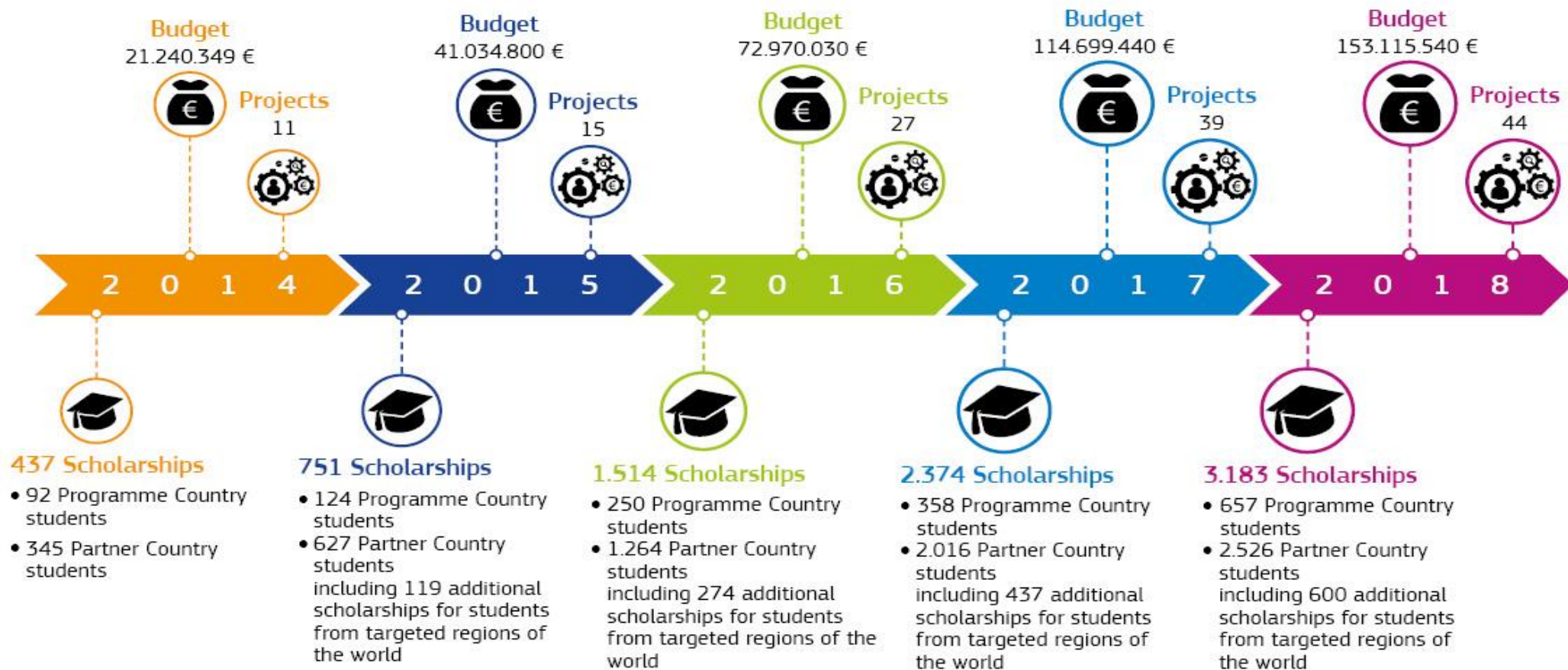

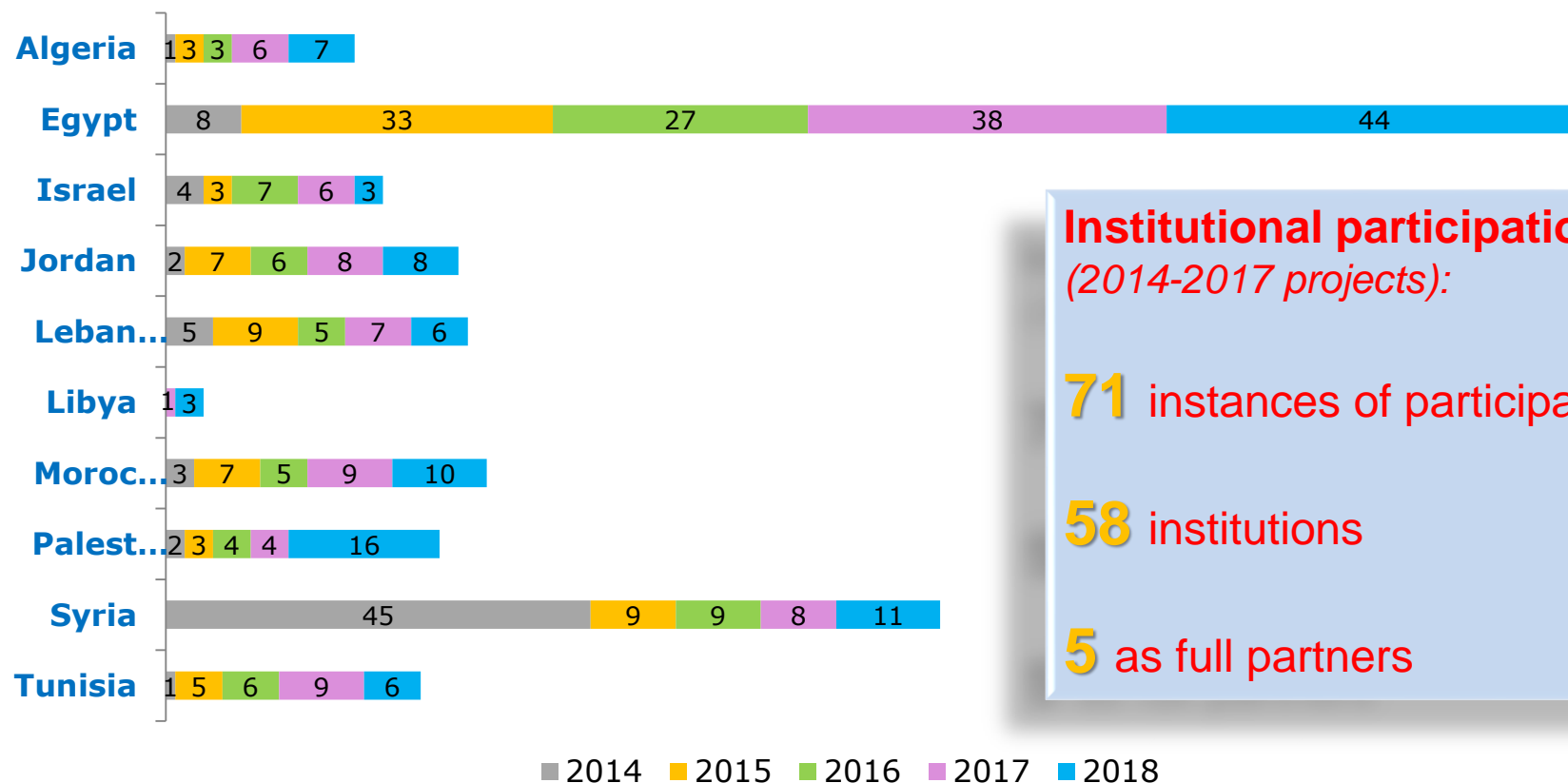

New elements in the 2019 EMJMD Call (2)

- ❖ **New Partnership** between **EMJMD** and the **Inter-University Exchange Project (IUEP)** of the Japanese Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT)
- ❖ Co-funding of 3-4 projects
- ❖ Consortia consisting of:
 - at least 3 HEIs from Erasmus+ Programme Countries &
 - at least 1 HEI from Japan
- ❖ Japanese partner HEI designated coordinator for the JPN side
- ❖ max 32 scholarships funded by EU (+ 32 scholarships by MEXT)
- ❖ 2 student mobility periods:
 - in a Japanese HEI and
 - in a Programme Country HEI
