

EMJMD EU grant ~ 3-4 million €

- 50.000 € per student intake (max 4)
- 20.000 € for optional preparatory year
- = 220,000 € max.


25.000 € max. per scholarship per academic year

- ✓ Consortia may receive up to <u>28</u> <u>additional scholarships</u>






Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees

...in brief:

- Increased budget for the 7-years-period
 - around 1 billion €
 - allowing to support ≈ 250 EMJMDs and
 - > **28.000 scholarship holders -** 75% for students from Partner Countries
- Selection results 2014 2018 (by academic discipline) Eligible proposals: 451




HS = **Hard Sciences**

LS = **Life Sciences**


Funded projects: 136 => 30% success rate








Five EMJMD selections at a glance



- 92 Programme Country students
- 345 Partner Country students
- 124 Programme Country students
- 627 Partner Country students including 119 additional scholarships for students from targeted regions of the world
- 250 Programme Country students
- 1.264 Partner Country students including 274 additional scholarships for students from targeted regions of the world
- 358 Programme Country students
- 2.016 Partner Country students including 437 additional scholarships for students from targeted regions of the world
- 657 Programme Country students
- 2.526 Partner Country students including 600 additional scholarships for students from targeted regions of the world



432 Master students selected in 2014-2018 (189 of which through additional ENI-South funding)





New elements in the 2019 EMJMD Call (2)

- New Partnership between EMJMD and the Inter-University Exchange Project (IUEP) of the Japanese Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT)
- Co-funding of 3-4 projects
- Consortia consisting of:
 - at least 3 HEIs from Erasmus+ Programme Countries &
 - at least 1 HEI from Japan
- Japanese partner HEI designated coordinator for the JPN side
- max 32 scholarships funded by EU (+ 32 scholarships by MEXT)
- 2 student mobility periods:
 - in a Japanese HEI and
 - in a Programme Country HEI
